 - \$35 for pets that are not spayed/neutered (not sterilized)Dog and cat ID microchips, with free registration, will also be available for \$15. Microchips can be scanned by a veterinarian or animal shelter if your pet gets lost. Debit/credit cards will be the only form of accepted payment. This is a change from prior events which used to accept cash. Cards accepted will include Visa, Master Card, American Express and Discover.
